Want to lower your monthly tuition payments? The two programs below describe how!

Shop With Scrip

Do you plan to buy gift cards for the holidays? This is a great way to do your holiday shopping and pay down your tuition!

Use Shop With Scrip to purchase or reload gift cards for a wide variety of stores and receive rebates to pay down your tuition. Credit percentages will be posted to your FACTS Tuition agreement monthly. Follow the directions below to create an account.

Physical gift card orders are processed generally every other Monday at 10:00am. **NEW!** Please see the 2020-2021 schedule posted on the BCS website. Please note: Only credit card and 'Presto Pay' orders will be processed. You can also purchase e-gift cards electronically anytime via SCRIPNOW. Questions ??? – Contact Kris Keady 610-868-6020

Coming soon! You will have the option to get physical gift cards from select brands shipped directly to your home — only in the SCRIP mobile app, RaiseRight.

Setting Up a Personal SCRIP Account

Go to the Scrip website at www.shopwithscrip.com.

1. Look to the top right of the web page and click on the button that says, "Join a Program."
2. On the next screen, ENROLL, you will be asked for the enrollment code. Enter the BSC code which is: E65L6F431514
3. The next screen will ask you for your personal information such as address, etc. Fill all this out and choose a username and password.
4. You may pay with a credit card or with Presto Pay. Presto Pay is a service that automatically withdraws money from your bank account in order to pay for your Scrip order. For each Scrip order, there is a \$.15 service charge that will be withdrawn along with the total of your order. For example, if you order \$200 worth of cards, \$200.15 will be withdrawn from your account. When signed into your Scrip account look for Presto Pay and click on that. You should receive specific instructions on setting up your Presto Pay account.

Redner's Receipts/1% Save-A-Tape Program

You must stop by a Redner's Customer Service desk to request a 1% Save-A-Tape card. Present it each time you shop. Save your receipts! Only tapes marked SAVE-A-TAPE on the bottom are usable. Do not remove any portion of the tape. Tapes must be dated within the last 3 years. Fold them so the Save-A Tape total faces up. When you have a substantial amount put them in an envelope; *write your Family Name, and "Redner's Receipts"* on the front and send them to either school office. Coca-Cola GIVE Program

If you or your family drink Coke products., send in your Rewards codes on the paper packaging of 12-32 can packs or in all bottle tops of most Coke products. There is a collection container in each school office. Your submissions will add to a quarterly payment to BCS.

All you need to do is collect your “Coke Points”. They have no specific date or deadline, and they can be sent in all year long. A BCS parent has graciously volunteered to do all of the data entry, so if you use Coke products, rather than tossing those points, please toss them our way!
