Bethlehem Christian School Dress Standard

The dress standard at Bethlehem Christian School is not intended to measure spirituality, but to serve as a tool in fostering the academic and character development of students as they participate in the business of education.

Dress Item	Description
Shirts, Blouses and Sweaters	 Girls: Oxford button down, peter pan – white or light blue Boys: Oxford button down – white or light blue Both: Polo – white or navy Oxford shirts must be tucked in Cardigan, v-neck, vest, or ¼ zip polar fleece jacket in navy
Pants, Shorts and Skorts	 Flat front – navy or khaki Solid brown, black or navy belts are required with pants and shorts Skorts and shorts may not exceed 3 inches above the top of the knee Form fitting pants are not allowed
Skirts and Jumpers	 Jumper for grades K-5 – navy, plaid, or khaki Skirts and jumpers may not exceed 3 inches above the top of the knee
PE attire/outerwear worn in the classroom	 All items must be purchased from Flynn & O'Hara or Lands End BCS T-shirt, BCS sweatshirt, BCS sweatpants, BCS Sports Team gear or navy ¼ zip polar fleece jacket w/BCS logo Sneakers with athletic socks
Hair	 Extreme colored hair or extreme hairstyles are prohibited. Hair must be clean, neat and should not obscure vision Hair should not be beyond collar length for boys
Accessories	 Caps/hats/bandanas/headscarves are not allowed to be worn in the school building Jewelry that is distracting or draws undue attention to the student is prohibited
Shoes	 Due to safety considerations on the playground; open toed and/or open heeled shoes are not allowed
Field Trip Attire	 The administration and/or trip director will specify the appropriate attire for each field trip
Leg wear	 Girls: Socks, tights, leggings – white, navy, black, gray or natural Boys: Socks are required – white, navy, black, gray or natural
Miscellaneous	 No visible body piercing is permitted Earrings are not permitted for male students. Tattoos are prohibited
Dress /Down Days	Adherence to BCS dress code standards still required
